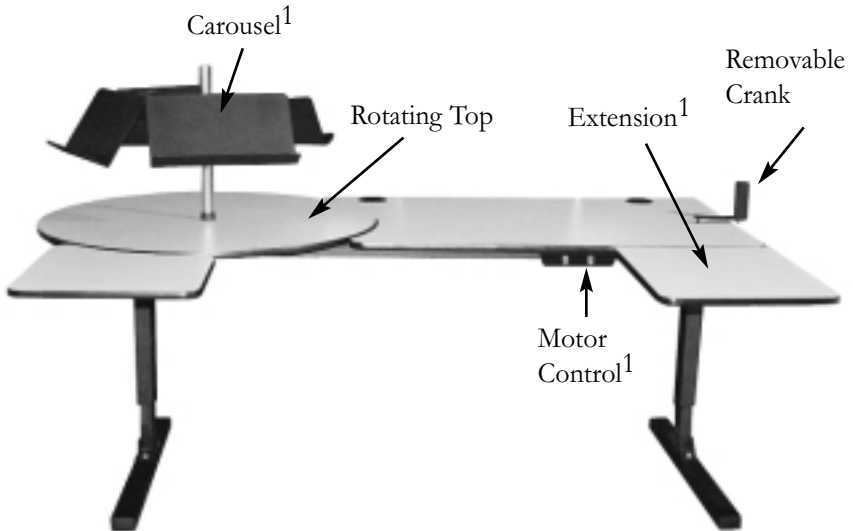


Modular QuadDesk



The Modular QuadDesk is different from any other desk on the market in that it was designed from the ground up with you, the wheelchair user, in mind.

Designed by a person with a C3-C4 spinal cord injury that left him paralyzed from the neck down, the modular QuadDesk was developed so that you could create a workspace that meets your particular needs, and makes you both more comfortable, and more productive.

The picture shows some of the modular QuadDesk's unique features.

As shown, unlike other desks, the QuadDesk has only two legs and no crossbeams. This allows you to not only wheel in-and-out of the desk easily, but to also maneuver around the desk without having to worry about bumping your wheelchair, knees or legs on crossbeams, and desk legs.

In addition, while a conventional desk with a fixed height of 26" to 29" would force you into uncomfortable and ergonomically unsafe postures and positions, the QuadDesk's height can be easily adjusted to meet your needs.

Finally, because people in wheelchairs often can not lean, reach, or grip, conventional desks restrict them to the desk's front area, greatly

reducing the workspace available. The QuadDesk overcomes this problem with a rotating top that enables people to retrieve items without having to lean or reach.

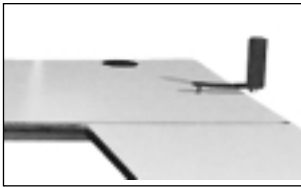
In summary, conventional desks force you, the wheelchair user, to adjust to the desk resulting in discomfort, lost productivity, or even worse, injury.

But as mentioned above, and described in more detail below, the modular QuadDesk allows you to adjust the workspace to meet your needs, rather than you having to adjust to it.

The QuadDesk is the only desk in the market that has:

- (1) a manual, or optional motorized, height adjustment,
- (2) a rotating desk top,
- (3) an optional rotating carousel for placing books, magazines, etc. at eye level, and
- (4) 14 possible configurations of sizes, and rotating top and extension placement.

Manual Height Adjustment:

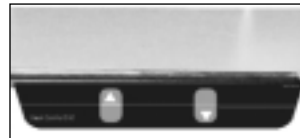


You can easily adjust the QuadDesk's height from a low of 26", to a high of 38", by simply turning the removable crank shown here. Our experience tells us that this 12" adjustment range is more than enough to meet your needs no matter how tall, or short, you are, or high or low

your wheelchair is.

Automatic or Motorized Height Adjustment:

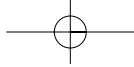
In addition to being used in an office, or home, the QuadDesk is also used in multi-user settings such as rehabs, classrooms, and libraries. In such settings the optional AutoHeight system allows people to change the desk height to meet their needs with the press of a button. The motor takes care of the rest.



And of course, like for the manually adjusted desk, users can adjust the height from a low of 26" to a high of 38".

Rotating Top:

As we mentioned earlier, because people in wheelchairs often can not lean, reach, or grip, they must keep needed items near the front of the desk. The



severely limits the amount of effective desk workspace available to them.

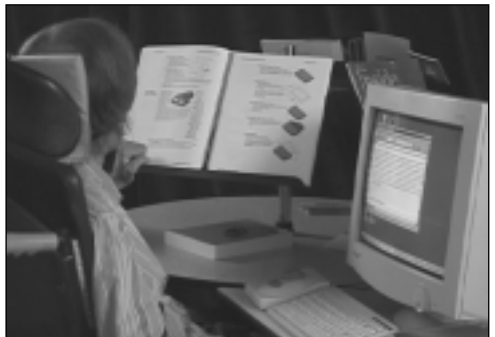
The QuadDesk overcomes this problem with a built-in 38" diameter rotating top or Lazy-Susan. By keeping frequently used items on the rotating top, even people who can not reach or grip can simply rotate the Lazy-Susan to conveniently access items on the desk.

And, since the rotating top rests on high quality permanently oiled and sealed bearings it can be rotated with the lightest of touches over a life-time.

Moreover, to further enhance convenience, comfort, and productivity you can get the QuadDesk with the rotating top on the left or right side, as best suits you.

Carousel:

Like the rotating top the optional carousel also provides additional workspace. However even more important is the fact that by adjusting its height you can place documents, books, and magazines, at a level where they are most comfortable to read and reach.



This not only helps improve your posture and reduce eyestrain but also prevents you from injuring, or feeling discomfort in your neck and back.

In addition the carousel is designed so that it turns independently of the rotating top. This allows you to rotate the carousel with a light touch without turning the rotating top.



Side Extensions:

The thoughtfulness with which the QuadDesk was designed does not end with these features. In addition to the above features the optional side extensions allow you to add more workspace, and configure the QuadDesk to meet your needs more precisely.

Not only does each extension add more than 370 sq. in. of additional work space, a desk with both extensions results in a U shaped design that wraps around you without impeding you, or your wheelchair, in any way.

Available Configurations and Sizes:

Finally, in order to ensure that your work environment meets your particular needs you can order the QuadDesk in any one of the 14 different configurations shown below.

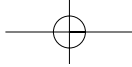
As the figure shows, you can (1) choose between two sizes, large and medium (80" or 74" wide) desks, (2) have the rotating top on the left or right, and (3) choose which side, if any, you want the extension on.

In summary, as you can see, the modular QuadDesk was developed from the ground up to meet your particular needs, and to make you more comfortable and productive, than a conventional desk ever could.
